After that, he was sent off to Europe to help lead Microsoft's response to the EU anti-trust dispute. He then returned to Redmond to oversee regulatory approvals for acquisitions as VP of the Industry Affairs Group. In 2013 he left Microsoft to join Starbucks where he is now putting his considerable skills and experience to work.
