Where: Seattle Ferry Terminal (Colman Dock), 801 Alaskan Way Pier 52, Seattle

When: Thursday, October 20th

- 10:45 am: Arrive at terminal and purchase tickets. The group will meet near the ticket booth on the passenger level in Colman Dock.
- 11:10 am: Ferry departs Seattle for a round trip sailing to Bremerton.
- 1:20 pm: Approximate time of arrival back in Seattle.

Getting there: Parking is available on the street and in lots near Colman Dock. Access the terminal via the Marion Street pedestrian bridge or at street level. We will meet at the ticket booth in the upper level passenger terminal.
