## KEY HIGHLIGHTS FROM MAY 26TH PROGRAM

- Actress Molly Ringwold was introduced as a surprise guest, greeted by most of the membership, but alas, she was a no show!
- Program: Chief Williamson, of Bakersfield Police Department. He has a BS and MPA, and he is involved in many organizations and is a fellow Rotarian. He is a North High graduate, an "a good ol' Oildale boy". The chief's family has a long relationship with law enforcement and public service in our community.

His discussion topics were:

<u>Marijuana Shops</u> in Bakersfield. We have 60 Medical Marijuana clinics. He thinks there is an uptick in crime around these facilities. He stated that there are several propositions on the ballot regarding Marijuana. BPD deals with this issue civilly.

<u>Community Relations</u>: Despite the national and state news, the Bakersfield Police Department enjoys a good relationship with the community for the most part. He stated that good news doesn't normally hit the media channels, so he invited us to go to the BPD website.

<u>AB109</u> (Release of nonviolent predators into the community). Kern has had over 2,000 people released from state prisons. Crime figures were not originally increasing as anticipated, but trends are now going up.

<u>Prop 47</u> Safe Neighborhoods and School Act". The act eliminated numerous felony crimes. BPD gets to give many criminals a ticket rather than arresting and taking the person to jail

<u>Jail Population</u>: The population has decreased at Lerdo Facility, but there are folks staying at Lerdo for longer sentences.

There is not currently enough dollars available per the city manager and the city council.
