Russell provided a great overview of the history of the hospital and was excited to share that Kern Medical is happy to celebrate 150 years in the community.

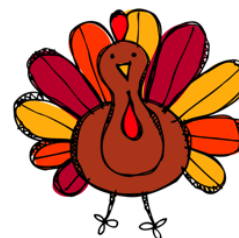

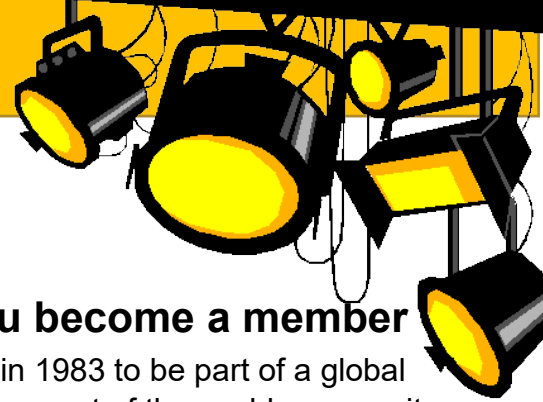
