Mike and Geoff are from the Water Company and came to speak to us about the clean-up of the chemical 1,2,3-TCP in our water. TCP is a chlorinated hydrocarbon that was used in pesticide products and has be known to cause cancer. Granular activated carbon (GAC) is the only viable treatment option for TCP removal. They get GAC from Coconut Shells and 1 gram of activated carbon can have a surface area of 1500m2. It binds molecules through Van der Walls force and it can be regenerated. The clean-up is going well and Progress to Date include 16 completed well sites, 6 sites under construction, 22 22 concrete pads completed and 68 GAC vessels installed.




