## Coming to America—The Immigration Process

Rena Kay had asked Michele Auriemma to speak to the club about the immigration process. Michele was born in Naples, had lived in Milan and Venice. He has a degree in Chemical Engineering & Recycling. He was invited to the United States by Ben Sacco who owned Sierra Recycling, so Michele said he had no problems coming to America since he had a job and a house awaiting. His only problem is the pronunciation and spelling of his name, since here it is A female name.

He did speak of the great bonds between Italy and the U.S. After all are country is named after the Italian Explorer, Amerigo Vespucci and one of the biggest banks in the U.S., Bank of America started as The Bank of Italy. The bank of Italy was founded by Amadeo Giannini in San Francisco to help the Italian merchants. During the San Francisco fire in 1906, Amadeo took all the bank money and hide it in his fireplace in Oakland, California, which saved all the merchants money.

Michele did give us some history of Italy. During the mid 1800, the county was in a civil war causing the poor people to leave the country. Up to 1000 per day where fleeing the county and many came to the US. Here they took the jobs that no one else wanted and banded in communities, trying to make it look like home.

Another example of the bond between the U.S. and Italy was the friendship of Gaetano Filangieri and Ben Franklin. Their relationship is said to have influenced the shaping of the Founding Father's thinking about the governing the early republic.

Michele had many more interesting facts he shared, it was a very good talk and a chance to learn More about one of our Rotarians.
