One of our goals is to provide scholarships for qualified **re-entry students with financial need living in the Camarillo area**. The number of awards given annually is based on funds available.

THE CURRENT AWARD IS AT LEAST \$1000 PER STUDENT

Requirements for receiving a scholarship are:

- Have experienced a cumulative gap in their education of four or more years
- Must be pursuing an academic or vocational education degree
- Must be attending a publicly funded school
- Be enrolled full or part time at an accredited institution
- Must demonstrate financial need
- Must show academic promise and commitment to completing the enrolled program

Basis of Award: To assist a re-entry student who performs well academically. This student will also be recognized in such areas as:

- Community service activities
- Sports related accomplishments
- Career/work efforts
- Support of school
- Support of family

Application and selection procedures:

- If eligible, submit the application. **Incomplete applications will not be accepted for review.**
- Qualified candidates will be scheduled for a face-to-face discussion with a review panel comprised of Camarillo Rotary Club members.
- Winners will be selected by the Camarillo Rotary Club panel and presented with the award at a Wednesday Rotary luncheon (your family is invited and encouraged to attend).
