

Rotary Club of Cambria Foundation Ball Drop Rules:

1. Entry fees are \$20 (for 2 balls), 5 balls for \$40, 8 balls for \$60, 12 balls for \$80, or 20 balls for \$100. Each participant will be entered into the RCCF Ball Drop to take place on Wednesday, June 2, 2021. Participants may enter more than once. Participants will be assigned a numbered ball(s) based on their entry. All participants must be 18 years of age or older.
2. On Wednesday, June 2, 2021 the ball closest to the center of the target, wins \$1,500. If more than one ball is equal distance from the center of the target, the winners will split the prize. Other prizes will be awarded for different measurements from the target. The ball drop will be videotaped and available by request, on our website, and posted on Facebook
3. The ball landing the closest to the target will win. The ball closest to the target will be determined by measuring the distance from the center of the target. The winners in receding order in the event the first-place prize winner does not claim his/her prize.
4. The winner will be announced at the site of the Ball Drop and need not be present to win. The winner will be notified via phone and/or email in the event the winner is not present.
5. If the Ball Drop should be cancelled for any reason, a new drop date will be rescheduled.

If the winner cannot be located or fails to claim the first prize within thirty days (30) after notification, the prize will be forfeited and awarded to the next winner in line as provided under the Ball Drop Rules above. If no winner comes forth after attempting to contact the four separate, sequential winners as provided in the Ball Drop Rules above, then the first prize will be forfeited.

By participating, each participant releases, discharges, indemnifies, and holds harmless the Rotary Club of Cambria The Rotary Club of Cambria Foundation & San Simeon Lodge, and the hired ball drop company, their relative subsidiary, successor and affiliated companies/organizations, and their respective officers, directors, employees, agents and representatives, advertising agencies and promotional partners (collectively the "Releases") from any and all liability, loss, harm, injury, damage, cost and expense whatsoever arising directly or indirectly from the use of the first prize or participation in the raffle.
10. All federal, state and local taxes are the sole responsibility of the individual winner.
