POTATO GLEANING FOR THE HUNGRY

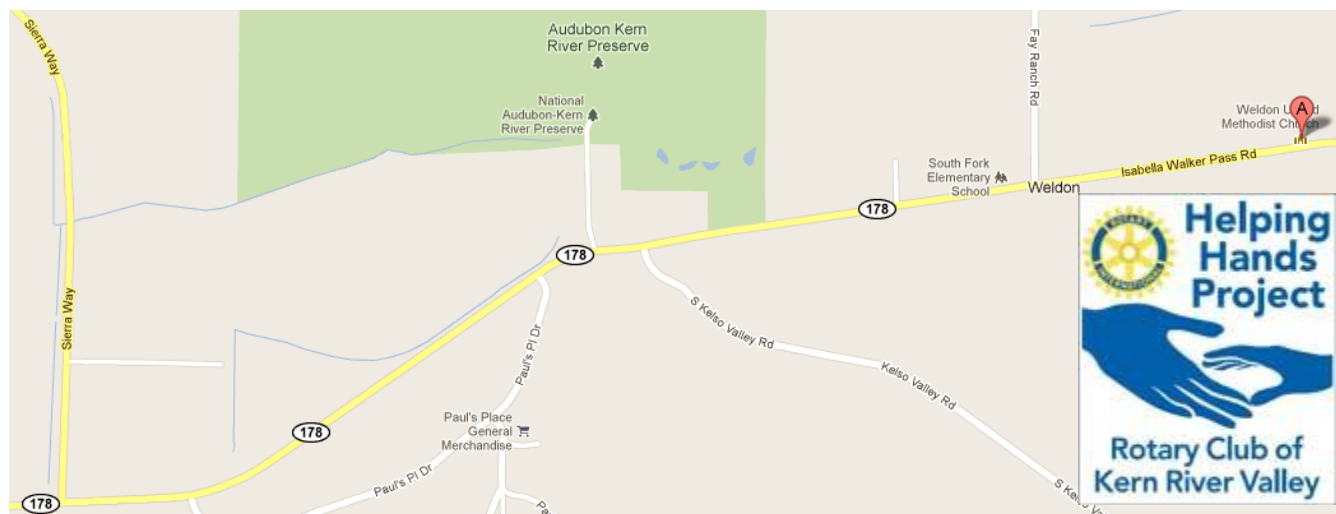
