



2016 CHRISTMAS TREE LIGHTING & LIGHTED BOAT PARADE VENDOR INFORMATION

We invite you to join us for the Morro Bay's Annual Christmas Tree Lighting and Rotary Club of Morro Bay's Lighted Boat Parade being held on Saturday December 10th beginning at 3:30 pm. This event is drawing on its years of success and attracts approximately 10,000 visitors from throughout California.

DATE/TIME: Saturday December 10th; beginning at 3:30pm

PLACE: Tidelands Park

RULES & REGULATIONS:

- **SET UP: Begin at 2pm on Saturday, December 10th.
NO VEHICLES ALLOWED ON SITE AFTER 3pm.**
- Vendors will set up and staff their own displays and handle their own sales. Displays must be set up by 3pm and remain open until the conclusion of the Parade. Food vendors will be required to remove all waste, oils, water or other spoils from the site. **No waste products may be dumped at the event.**
- Proof of Insurance is required. Please provide a copy with your application.
- Each exhibitor is responsible for providing and securing his or her own display. The Festival cannot be responsible for loss or damage.
- Only items as described in your application may be sold.

The City of Morro Bay requires you to post your resale permit on your booth. You will also be required to provide us your resale number for the State of California Board of Equalization. The Morro Bay City Fire Department may require that you provide a 2A: 10BC Fire Extinguisher. If you are a food vendor, San Luis Obispo County requires you to post your Department of Public Health permit on your booth. San Luis Obispo County's Rules and Regulations regarding food vendors will be strictly enforced.

- **TEARDOWN: No vehicles will be allowed in the prior to 9pm or at such time that the Parade director deems safe.** Just as you did during setup, drive directly to your space, park so that other vehicles may pass, load your vehicle immediately and drive out as soon as possible. Please observe the one way traffic pattern as directed. **All Teardown must be complete by 10 pm with all garbage and waste must be removed from the site. No waste products may be dumped at the event.**
