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GOT EARWAX???

Manual Removal is Not Recommended -OUCH

Ear wax was the topic ... also known as ceruminosis (say that three times fast). Ear wax is actually a protective covering for the ear canal; shields from water damage, infection and trauma. The ear canal is shaped like an hour glass.

Ear buds, hearing aids, q-tips can obstruct the ear canal. Some people produce more wax than others ... and get this—aging causes your ear wax to get harder (Geez). GOT too much ear wax—you can get over the counter drops or try self irrigation using luke warm water; manual removal is not recommended (ALAN). Micro-Lending in Africa



The Greater Contribution is a non-profit organization that provides women in object poverty with micro loans to support their businesses or to start a business. The organization, which was founded in 2006 has given out some 10,000 loans to women in Uganda. Uganda was selected because it is the poorest country in the world, with a population of 37 million people.

Why loan to women? Women in most instances are the breadwinner in Africa. When you loan to a woman—she will start a business and the whole family gets involved. Micro loans typically range from \$50 to \$250. The loans are given to a group of 20 women who cross guarantee each other's loans. Groups meet every two weeks to make loan payments and support each other. Loans are repaid in full every six months. In addition to loans—the organization provides three days of business training.
