Meeting of August 3rd, 2011 Offsite Event – National Weather Service Station Reporter: lim Spancer

INTRODUCTION.

As our normal Derby Club venue is unavailable due to the County Fair, Club Service Director Terry Schaeffer arranged for an offsite lunch-tour-lecture at the National Weather Service office in Oxnard.

NO FORMAL PROGRAM.

To avoid overwhelming the facility, our flock of 72 Rotarians (including a few guests) split into three groups. No formal Rotary business was conducted. The groups rotated through three educational sessions presented by Meteorologist-In-Charge Mark Jackson, Operations Manager Dave Sweet, and Warning Coordination Meteorologist Eric Boldt.

SCOPE.

While members enjoyed a catered box lunch in the conference room, Meteorologist-In-Charge Mark Jackson explained the broad scope of the facility's operations.

The NWS Oxnard office is one of 122 district offices across the nation. It provides a broad range of services relating to forecasting and tracking weather for the four county area of San Luis Obispo, Santa Barbara, Ventura and Los Angeles.

The 27 staff professionals provide 24-hour per day forecasts, programs and services, including climate services, aviation weather information forecasts, general public weather forecasting, marine weather forecasting, weather radio broadcasts, collection of data and the issuance of warnings regarding water, flood watches, marine warnings and the like.

OPERATIONS.

From his bank of screens at the Aviation and Marine Desk, Operations Manager Dave Sweet shared real time insights into the local operation. It is charged with providing the official forecasts for aviation conditions at eleven (11) public airports in the four county area, including LAX. Additionally, the office forecasts marine weather extending out 60 nautical miles.

Forecasts are updated throughout the day to provide information for flight planning, pilot reports, terminal forecasts and advisories regarding wind, weather and a host of information for boaters and ocean-going ships.

OUTBACK.

Weather forecasts and warnings are sent to most television, radio and other media outlets in the area. These releases often constitute the primary source of data for the weather segments in on-air public broadcasts.

In addition to his other duties coordinating the issuance of weather warnings, Eric Boldt is the media contact for the office when the news media or the public seek additional weather information, including interviews.

Eric guided guests through a show-in-tell tour of sample instruments and equipment set-up for public information in a park-like attraction at the rear of the NWS property. Rotarians learned how the NWS measures ocean swells and the depth of snow pack, the visibility ceiling at airports, as well as how rain fall is measured and data is collected from various sources.
