Crista Hermance gave a Craft Talk at our meeting August 9, 2023. She was born in Ventura and attended Anacapa Middle School and Ventura High School. She served as a volunteer assisting victims for the Ventura County District Attorney's Office and the Coalition to End Family Violence.

After obtaining her law degree from Southern California Institute of Law, she worked as an associate in a law firm. She then opened her own firm, Hermance Law, where she specializes in estate planning for families with small children.

Crista prepares complete estate plans including powers of attorney, advance health care directives and HIPAA, wills, revocable living trusts, and guardian nominations for minor children,

Crista gave examples of three troublesome probate cases that could have been avoided:

The holographic will (handwritten, unwitnessed). An elderly woman left everything to her sister but did not acknowledge that she had a son from whom she was estranged. When he showed up, he got a big portion of the estate that his mother likely did not want him to have.

The transfer-on-death deed. Because the assessor's parcel number was left off, the heirs bore the expense of going to court to get the property transferred.

Caring for an aging parent. In one case, the mother died while her adult child was going through the conservatorship process. He then had to start over with probate. It could have been avoided with a trust.

Crista's husband is a contractor for the military. They have two young daughters. She loves scuba diving, underwater photography, and travel, and has ridden an elephant in Thailand. She will soon be going to Guam and plans to visit Rotary clubs there.

August 16 lunch meeting: Janet Barron, CASA (Court Appointed Special Advocates). CASA of Ventura County is a non-profit serving children and families involved in the Child Welfare System in Ventura County since 1985. In 2019, it began serving youth in the Juvenile Justice System. Volunteers receive extensive training, are sworn in by the court. and are assigned to one or more abused or neglected youth to seek the best outcome for them in the system.

Janet Barron has worked for CASA of Ventura County for over 10 years, serving as Training Manager for most of that time, where she schedules and delivers the pre-service training and continuing education for all CASA volunteers. Janet was instrumental in onboarding the programs (including developing the training) to serve both infants and toddlers and older youth (18-21) through Extended Foster Care. She enjoys getting to know the volunteers as they move through the

application and training process to become sworn advocates. Additionally, Janet volunteered as a CASA, mentoring a young woman from age 15 until she aged out of the system at age 21. She is now 23 and they are still in contact.

Janet is an experienced advocate for women's and social justice issues and has held leadership positions in local chapters of the National Organization for Women, Santa Barbara Women's Political Committee and Coalition Against Gun Violence. She also served in various capacities, including President, on her children's elementary school PTA and as the Pack Committee Chair for her son's Cub Scout Pack. Janet holds a Bachelor's degree in psychology and a Master's degree in Public Health Education from CSUN.
