

JULIUS GIUS MEMORIAL ROTARY FOUNDATION





We learned about the Julius Gius Memorial Rotary Foundation (JGMRF) at our meeting August 23, 2023, from this year's JGMRF President, Saurabh Bajaj. The JGMRF is the Rotary Club of Ventura's own 501(c)(3) foundation, dedicated to support non-profit and service organizations through grants and give scholarships to benefit members of our Ventura community.

The Foundation was created in 1998 in honor of Julius Gius, who was a member of the Rotary Club of Ventura, Editor of the Star-Free Press, and a philanthropist. Since its creation, it has given almost \$900,000 in grants and scholarships to many recipients, including the Brain Injury Center, Boys and Girls Club, Food Share, Project Understanding, educational initiatives, *(continued...)*

persons with disabilities, veterans, and many more.

Because Saurabh is "a sign guy," he decided the JGMRF needed a logo. He unveiled the new logo at the meeting, which signifies a helping hand, a hand of friendship, and moving forward.

The JGMRF is funded by automatic donations of \$45 per quarter per member (you can elect to give more), additional member donations, and outside donations. The JGMRF supports local organizations and students. In contrast, The Rotary Foundation, which we also support, supports causes throughout the country and the world. Within the JGMRF are scholarships funded by the Joe Taylor Endowment and the Everett Millais Endowment.

You may choose to give a monthly, quarterly, one-time donation to the JGMRF, which will be distributed in grants that year. Or you can give a monthly, quarterly, or one-time donation to the JGMRG endowment, where your money continues to work in perpetuity. (Only the earnings on endowment funds are spent while the principal remains intact.) Those who give at least \$1,000 to the endowment are JGMRF Fellows, who will receive a special pin now under production.

Saurabh distributed a donation slip to support the important work of the JGMRF. (See end of newsletter.)
