<u>Dr. Margaret Martin, founder of the Harmony Project,</u> gave an overview of how the program began and some of it's achievements over the past 10 years. The first Harmony Project was funded by a \$9,000 gift from the Rotary Club of Hollywood.

It costs \$1200 - \$1500 per year per child for instruction and instruments. Many of the instruments are donated to the program and then rented or loaned to the children. Ms Martin expanded on the benefits of the program to disadvantaged youth and her goal of growing the current Project throughout schools in Ventura.

Following questions from the audience, Lynda thanked the speaker and adjourned the meeting at 1:30.
