

A member of the Rotary Club of Santa Maria Breakfast since 1998, Frank served as their 20th Club President in 2003-2004. That year, his Club was named 'Outstanding Medium Size Club' for District 5240. He held Club offices as Secretary, International Service, Vocational Service, and TRF; as well as their Rotary Centennial Park co-chair. Key leadership positions at the District level include Group Representative and Assistant Governor, each for 2 years; 2008 District Conference Chair; 2009 Foundation Gala Chair; District Personnel Committee; District Governor Nominating Committee; Vocational Service Director; Community Service Director; and Rotary Foundation Area Representative.

Frank holds a Bachelors Degree in Business Management from Saint Mary's College and a Master's Degree in Emergency Services Administration from CSU Long Beach. He is a Master PRLS Graduate, and a Charter Member of the District 5240 Paul Harris Society. His wife, Scottie, is a Multiple Paul Harris Fellow. The couple has traveled to Mexico, South Korea, and Nigeria in the name of Rotary. In 2007, they participated on a Polio NID in Nigeria.

In 2005-2006, Frank was named Group Representative of the Year, and was honored as the Co-District Rotarian of the Year in 2008-2009. Frank and Scottie reside in Santa Maria, where Frank served as the City's Fire Chief from 1997-2009. He retired in 2009 after serving 33 years in the fire service profession.









- Dan Holmes, Club Service Chair, introduced his committee leadership. His co-chair is Mario de la Piedra
