PRESENTATION BY JANNY FRANKEN

The presentation at our meeting June 14, 2023, was from Janny [yani] Franken. Janny is accredited by the International Coaching Federation, has completed its training, practice, and testing requirements, and is subject to its professional standards. The ICF defines "coaching" as "Partnering with clients in a thoughtprovoking and creative process that inspires them to maximize their personal and professional potential."



Janny provided us with small containers of Play-Doh. This reminds us that we are all creative, resourceful people.

As a coach, Janny asks the individual questions and listens deeply to their answers to help move the person forward in their future. Coaching is not about fixing people, it is about empowering them to create their own solutions. In coaching, the client is the expert, is whole, and is capable of achieving their own goals. In contrast, when we give advice to others, our advice is not nearly as good as we think it is, and we send the message that the person cannot solve the problem themselves.

Janny was born and raised in the Netherlands, where she earned a Bachelor's degree in Pedagogy and a Master's degree in Educational Sciences. There, she advised parents and professionals to improve their ability to work with and raise children and youth with special needs. She was hired to improve a group of three Dutch schools in Southern California, and guided a church to grow and improve their child and youth ministries. She also guided a church to become an openly welcome LGBTQ+ church. She is proud to have her own coaching business. Her best work is done through one-on-one coaching relationships.
