PRESENTATION – CECILIA RAMIREZ CID – strwEATs



At our meeting on March 15, 2023, we had a presentation by Cecilia Ramirez Cid, founder and owner of strwEATs. Cecilia is in seventh grade in Oxnard and started the company shortly after turning 12. She launched the company after attending a Junior CEO program, and has received awards as a young entrepreneur. Through the business, she has learned how to manage money, manage her time, bear more responsibility, and serve as a model to other young people.

The company makes cupcakes, tamales, jam, and other treats, all infused with one of our region's most popular and delicious crops: strawberries!

Cecilia received a \$5,000 grant from Jordache to launch a product on DoorDash. She has sold her creations at festivals, including developing an avocado-strawberry cupcake for the Avocado Festival, and a strawberry lemonade for the Lemon Festival. She shared a video with people lined up to buy her goods. She made \$20,000 in sales in 2022 and the business is going strong!
