

Sri Lankan Group Study Exchange Team Visits

Today's program features the Group Study Exchange (GSE) team from Rotary International District 3220 in Sri Lanka. The team leader, a Rotarian, and five energetic young non-Rotarian professionals are in our District 5240, having arrived on September 24 and departing October 23, 2012.

The group is led by a Rotarian Past President G S Sylvester, a marketer by profession and a member of the Rotary Club of Colombo Mid Town. The team includes Nilumi Withanage, Biotechnologist, Kanchana Ranaweera, Architect, Seshika Fernando, Financial Analyst and Arjuna Wijekoon, Medical Doctor.

The GSE program gives participants an opportunity to learn about their vocation and how it is practiced in California, develop personal and professional relationships and exchange ideas. Team members have made presentation on Sri Lanka, its culture and diversity to Rotary Clubs in California and also at the California District 5240 conference.

Each GSE team member is hosted by a Rotarian family in California, who provides the warmth and support of a home away from home.

The family stay also gives an insight into lifestyles and culture of California.

Rotary first made its presence in Sri Lanka in February 1929, when the Rotary International District 322 South India extended the Rotary Club of Colombo. Sri Lanka has also been an active participant in the Group Study Exchange Programme for the past 45 years and has alumni, which currently has a membership of over 100 past team members and team leaders.

Program

Ventura Unified School District Superintendent, Trudy Tuttle Arriaga, was our speaker. She has been serving 12 years (typical national is 3.5 yrs). She spoke on the state of education in the VUSD. Highlights of her presentation were:

- There is stability at the board and administrative level.
- VUSD is not a 'one size fits all' set of programs.
 There a variety of learning environments, including Alternative Education Programs and open classrooms.
- The recently established DeAnza Academy Technology and Arts, a technology driven school, is attracting students from throughout the district.
- The Ventura Education Partnership, which provides private fundraising, raised \$250,000.00
- The district comprises 28 facilities.
- VUSD has created a Wellness Policy, going beyond state requirements for food service.
- All schools participate in community service.



- The district has early childhood programs, identifying specific child needs even before kindergarten.
- The Arts Master Plan, despite cutbacks, is being maintained.
- VUSD is part of a Green Schools partnership-reducing waste and promoting other methods of sustainability.
- The district boasts a balanced budget with no audit findings. The budget can be reviewed online.
- VUSD was voted CABE district of the year 2011for its innovative multilingual program.
- 21 schools distinguished schools
- Drop out rate in the VUSD is 2%, while the national rate is 4%

Superintendent Arriaga discussed future challenges, particularly possible severe state funding reductions. With some education funding propositions, locally and state-wide, on the ballot in November, she asked us to carefully consider our choices.




NEW MEMBER PROPOSAL

The flag of Sri Lanka, also called the Lion Flag, consists of a gold lion, holding a kastane sword in its right fore paw, in front of a crimson background with four golden bo leaves, one in each corner. Around the background is a yellow border, and to its left are 2 vertical stripes of equal size in green and saffron, with the saffron stripe closest to the lion. The lion represents the Sinhalese ethnicity and the bravery of the Sri Lankan nation while the four Bo leaves represent Mettā, Karuna, Mudita and Upekkha. The orange stripe represents the Sri Lankan Tamils, the green stripe represents Sri Lankan Moors, and the maroon background represents the majority of Sinhalese, like the lion, this is the color used in early flags of Sri Lanka by kings.
