Sarah Abrams, co-founder of the non-profit Love VC, gave a presentation at our meeting September 28, 2022. She has been a volunteer for many years in places like Jamaica, South Africa, and the Tenderloin District. Love VC, Inc. was trademarked in November 2021. It is a 501(c)(3), volunteer based, with a small board of four people. Its goals are: Connecting, Giving, Serving. Its top priority is the City of Ventura but it also helps others in the county. There is no overhead—100% of monies go to the projects.

Their first event is October 1st where 175 volunteers will work on ten different projects serving the needs of our community. Three of the ten projects are:

- Hosting a baby shower at the Tenderlife Maternity Home,
- Refurbishing the outdoor spaces at the Cal Vet Home on Eastside,
- Pierpont Beach Clean-up.
