Program:

Steve Doll introduced the speaker for our Program. Michael Powers (pictured), the Director of the Health Care Agency, aka HAS, gave us a complete view of the health care services his organization provides.



These services are provided by VCMC, Santa Paula, 14 community clinics, 16 specialty clinics, 5 Public Health clinics, 23 Behavioral Health clinics, HMO/health Care Plan, and medical examiner. These agencies serve 1.7 million clients, with a staff of 3,000 and 300 physicians; they provide \$482 million of services,

7% Net county costs.

HAS offers the largest and oldest family medicine residency in the state; it is affiliated with UCLA and has currently 42 residents. The new facility will be able to expand the family medicine residency and specialty care center.
