

What's New at the Reagan Presidential Library



Melanie Salvesen is the Marketing Outreach Assistant for the Ronald Reagan Presidential Foundation and will speaking about The Ronald Reagan Presidential Library and Museum. She will focus on their newly renovated state-of-theart interactive galleries, special exhibits, upcoming events and educational outreach programs.

The Ronald Reagan Presidential Foundation is the nonprofit organization created by President Reagan himself and specifically charged by him with continuing his legacy and sharing his principles-individual liberty, economic opportunity, global democracy and national pride. The Foundation is a non-partisan organization which sustains the Ronald Reagan Presidential Library and Museum, the Reagan Center for Public Affairs, the Walter and Leonore Annenberg Presidential Learning Center and its internationally recognized, award-winning Discovery Center, and the Air Force One Pavilion.

Our speaker acts as "ambassador" for individual tourists and adult/senior tour groups seeking to visit the Ronald Reagan Presidential Library and Museum. The Marketing Outreach Assistant is responsible for assisting with Tourism Industry Tradeshows, giving Library presentations at Rotary and Republican Clubs, creating partnerships with local hotels and Chamber of Commerces, and visiting/attending other similar events to promote tourism to the Reagan Library.

Before coming to The Reagan Foundation in August of 2010, Melanie worked at GE/NBC Universal for over 15 years and created large events and business development opportunities for technology companies all over southern California. Before moving from Chicago, Melanie held a Series 3 as a Commodities Broker and was a Company Manager of many equity productions including Driving Miss Daisy and Steel Magnolias.
