



## **Quilting materials needed to help the people of Pine Ridge Reservation, South Dakota**

### **Fabrics to Donate**

- Clean cotton or cotton blend fabric, at least ¼ yard or a fat quarter or larger (washed fabric is fine)
  - Basic colors: black, red, yellow, white, green, blue.

### **Notions to Donate**

- Basic portable sewing machines
- Hand and machine sewing needles, straight pins and safety pins
- Sharp scissors (medium and large)
- Seam rippers
- Rotary cutters, sharp cutter blades, cutting mats
- Hand quilting needles
- Quilting thread: black, red, yellow, white, green, blue
- Wide cotton hem binding: black, red, yellow, white, green, blue
- Poly fiber for quilts

### **What NOT to Donate**

- Scraps of fabric smaller than a ¼ yard or fat quarter
- Pierced blocks and UFOs
- Polyester fabric
- Worn out notions – dull scissors or rotary blades, rusty pins, etc.
- Old thread (old thread is brittle and prone to breaking)

### **Wish list - young women's ceremonial attire**

- White cotton for lining
- Pastel solid colors
- Pastel small print design
- 1" and 2" wide ribbon for trim in 6 basic colors, and colors to go with pastel fabrics
