 - 2. High ethical standards in business and professions; the recognition of the worthiness of all useful occupations; and the dignifying of each Rotarian's occupation as an opportunity to serve society;
 - 3. The application of the ideal of service in each Rotarian's personal, business, and community life;
 - 4. The advancement of international understanding, goodwill, and peace through a world fellowship of business and professional persons united in the ideal of service.

LENGTH AND PRESENTATION

Essays should be typewritten and should be 350-500 words.

APPLICATION SCORING

Applications will be evaluated based on community service, employment history, financial need, demonstration of the ideals of service essay content and construction, and letter of reference. Applications will be evaluated by a volunteer committee of the Brattleboro Sunrise Rotary Club and the committee's decisions are final.
