



### Rotary's Four Way Test

Of the things we think, say or do:

First,  
Is it the Truth?

Second,  
Is it Fair to all concerned?

Third,  
Will it build Good Will and Better Friendships?

Fourth,  
Will it be Beneficial to all concerned?

The "Rotary Four Way Test" is a guide by which all Rotarians are asked to test themselves before making any response in any given situation. Read the above four questions carefully. You may write about the questions together as a group or choose the one question you feel is the most/least significant, or the one which you have already had experience at some point in your life. Being able to refer to a story from your own life, history, or even a memorable fictional character from literature can often illustrate your point effectively. There are many ways to examine the "Rotary Four Way Test". The underlying philosophy that supports all four questions may not be for everyone. Do not be afraid to take a position that may be yours alone. Write an essay that helps the committee get to know you best.
