Proposed Project Plan

Adult volunteers will volunteer on housing rehabilitation projects in Naguabo, Puerto Rico, serving elderly, disabled, or economically disadvantaged homeowner.

Wednesday, February 17 – Arrival Day

Arrival in San Juan, transfer to lodging, welcome dinner, orientation, and project briefing.

Thursday, February 18 – Housing Project Day 1

Full day of construction activities including demolition, framing, roofing, accessibility improvements, and site preparation.

Friday, February 19 – Housing Project Day 2

Continue major construction and rehabilitation activities. Evening group dinner.

Saturday, February 20 – Housing Project Day 3

Construction and finishing work. Evening dinner on your own at a local restaurant.

Sunday, February 21 – Exploration Day

Visit El Yunque National Forest, enjoy beach time in the afternoon, and evening bioluminescent bay kayak tour.

If we like, we can make this Sunday a work day and still do the evening bioluminescent bay kayak tour for fun- as Tuesday is a day with the Rotary Club in San Juan.

Monday, February 22 – Housing Project Day 4

Final construction push, landscaping, cleanup, and homeowner celebration.

Morning guided tour of Old San Juan, lunch with the San Juan Rotary Club, afternoon at Escambrón Beach, and dinner on your own.
