JAFFREY RINDGE ROTARY CLUB COMMUNITY SERVICE SCHOLARSHIP

RECOGNITION:

The Jaffrey/Rindge Rotary Club Scholarship is established to honor and to recognize a high school student for service to the community and academic excellence.

THE AWARD:

The recipient will receive a \$2,500 award to cover part of the costs for the freshman year at any college or graduate technical program of his or her choice. When there are two or more candidates of equal merit, the selection will be based on the individual who, by his or her actions, has best exemplified the Rotary ideal of "Service Above Self'.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

Applicants must be high school seniors from Conant High School who plan to go to college immediately following graduation. "They must have a record of community service and solid academic achievement.

APPLICATION DEADLINE AND REQUIRED MATERIALS:

All materials must be as a single package and returned to the Conant High School Counseling Office no later than Thursday 14 April 2016 at 3:00pm. The required materials are:

An official school transcript including the first semester grades for the senior year.

A completed Jaffrey/Rindge Rotary Club Community Service Scholarship form.

Two letters of recommendation from individuals who can address the applicant's contribution to the community.

THE AWARD PROCESS:

1) Application materials will be distributed to the high school Counseling Office with a request to post this form and also notify students of the award.

2) Students should compile all required materials and return a complete package to the CHS Counseling Office no later than 14 April 2016 at 3:00pm. All materials become the property of the Jaffrey/Rindge Rotary Club and cannot be returned.

3) A Scholarship Committee (non-parents of applicants) appointed by the Rotary Board of Directors will review all application materials. They will select the top applicant and present it to the Board of Directors at the May Board meeting.

4) The winning student will be notified of their status in the form of a letter by June 1st.

5) The recipient will be honored at a regular Rotary breakfast soon after notification. They will also be recognized at their school's scholarship awards assembly.

6) The Rotary Club Treasurer will pay the award amount to the student by June 30, 2016.
