SCHEDULE OF SEN. JOHN F. KENNEDY

New Hampshire - 1/25/60

Senator John F. Kennedy will kick-off his New Hampshire campaign with a day of appearances on Monday, January 25th. The Senator will be accompanied to New Hampshire by his wife, Jacqueline.

During the day, Senator Kennedy will appear in Nashua and Manchester. Following is a complete schedule of Senator Kennedy's New Hampshire trip:

- 10:00 a.m. Arrive State Line, Nashua, with Nashua Police escort. Proceed to City Hall.
- 10:15 a.m. Reception at City Hall for Senator and Mrs. Kennedy. Greetings from Mayor Mario J. Vagge. Moves from Mayor's Office to City Hall auditorium. Short address by Senator.
- 10:35 p.m. Twenty-minute public press conference with Senator Kennedy. Moderator, Nelson A. Bryant, Editor, CLAREMONT EAGLE.
- 10:55 a.m. to 11:10 a.m. Senator Kennedy greets personally those in attendance.
- 11:10 to 11:30 a.m. Leave City Hall for short walk, greeting citizens as he proceeds to AFL-CIO Hall on High Street. Greetings by Thoms J. Pitarys, State President AFL-CIO, and short reception with local labor leaders.
- 11:30 a.m. Leave Labor Hall for short street tour to County Court House to meet County officials and employees.
- 11:45 a.m. Arrive Court House for short greetings.
- 11:50 a.m. Leave Court House for gate at the J. F. McElwain Shoe Company to greet and talk with workers coming from the plant for noon recess.
- 12:05 p.m. Leave McElwain Shoe Company for Nashua Country Club with Nashua Police escort.
- 12:15 p.m. Arrive Nashua Country Club for 15-minute address to the Rotary Club. Remarks will be broadcast by Radio Station WOTW and WSMN.
- 12:35 p.m. Leave Nashua Country Club for trip to Manchester.
- 1:45 p.m. Reception at City Hall, Manchester, for Senator and Mrs. Kennedy. Greetings from Mayor Josaphat Benoit. Reception by city officials and employees. Reply by Senator Kennedy will be covered by Radio Stations WFEA, WKDR and WCIR.
- 2:40 p.m. to 3:10 p.m. Factory visit.
- 4:25 p.m. to 4:45 p.m. Visit to Manchester City Yard. Greetings with city employees.
- 4:45 p.m. to 5:25 p.m. Visit to Valley Street Shopping Center
- 7:30 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. Labor reception, Kennedy for President Headquarters, Lower Lobby, Carpenter Motor Hotel
- 8:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. Public reception for Senator and Mrs. Kennedy Ballroom - Carpenter Motor Hotel - Refreshments.
