2017 Queen City Rotary Club Grant Application Guidelines

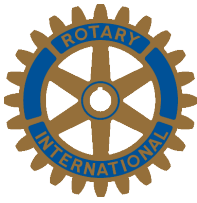
Grant Criteria and Priorities

Grants are made for projects, programs or events that meet the following priorities and criteria:

- **Population and Geographical Considerations:** Projects, events and programs that promote and support children in the greater Manchester area.
- **Application Criteria:** An application should include the amount requested, how the requested funds will be used, a description of the program or event that the funds will support, and the number of children who will benefit.
- **When and How to Apply:** The application deadline is **April 14th**. Annual grants are reviewed and distributed in the spring. Intermittent requests may be accepted and funds dispersed at the discretion of the Queen City Rotary Board of Directors. Requests should be submitted only once annually.

All application information for 2017 grants must be emailed to plabombarde@Anselm.Edu. DO NOT mail applications to the club's PO Box.

- **Organizational Status:** Requests made by organizations for donations will be duly considered from any legitimate tax-exempt organization under section 501 of the IRS code, or any local, state or regional organization located within New Hampshire that supports a charitable purpose or that demonstrates a commitment to enhancing the quality of life in the region.
- **Grant Award Range:** Grant awards typically range from \$500 to \$1,500.
- **Award Exclusions:** Queen City Rotary Club does not support:
 - Religious or political purposes
 - Deficit reduction or support of an activity that has already taken place
 - Support of general operating or administrative expenses
