



Pot of Gold Reverse Raffle Info Sheet

| Where: | Millyard Museum 200 Bedford Street Manchester (Use the Commercial Street Entrance for the event) |
| Time: | 5:00 (Doors Open) Raffle will run from 6:00 PM - 8:00 PM |
| Number of Tickets: | 250 maximum |
| Ticket Cost: | \$100 per Pot of Gold entry (Each ticket purchased grants entry for 2 people) |
| Grand Prize: | \$5,000.00 – Winner is expected to enjoy their winnings, NOT donate their prize back to the club. They need not be present to win. |
| Tickets: | Available from any Queen City Rotary member |
| Attire: | Business casual |
| Refreshments: | Beer and wine cash bar (CC accepted). Finger foods supplied by QCRC members. |
| Other Events: | 50/50 Raffle ongoing during the evening, CC accepted |
| Beneficiaries: | Manchester youth organizations, proceeds to be awarded in spring of 2022 |

How does a reverse raffle work?

- Each ticket holder's ticket is entered into the large drawing (and displayed on large white boards)
- As each ticket is drawn, the individual who is listed on the ticket is eliminated from winning the grand prize.
- Drawing will continue until TWO tickets remain. The remaining players may opt to split the \$5,000 pot, if present, or continue for the final drawing for a sole winner. (Basically, the last person standing is the overall winner (barring a split of the top prize). The ultimate winner need not be present to win.
- First ticket drawn will receive a \$100 check or free entry into next year's raffle.
- Smaller prizes will be awarded along the way from items donated/gathered by club members.
