That the winning frog was deaf.

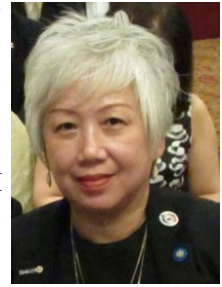
