Dr Paul Lee is a dentist by profession.


He graduated from the University of Singapore and joined our Rotary Club of Pudu in 1976.

He served as our Club President in RY 1984/85 and District Governor in RY 1998/99.


Paul has also served Rotary International in the various Rotary International Task Forces and Committees.

Paul was also President of the Malaysian Dental Association and Malaysian Private Dental Practitioners's Association.











































































