## Women's Dairy Coop in India



In the village of Sone Sanghavi, 100 women contributed 100 Rupees each to form the **Shakti Mahila Women's Dairy Cooperative** with the help of the **Ashta No Kai** (For a Better Tomorrow) foundation. Thirty pregnant cows and dairy equipment was purchased with a Rotary Foundation matching grant sponsored by The Rotary Club of Doylestown



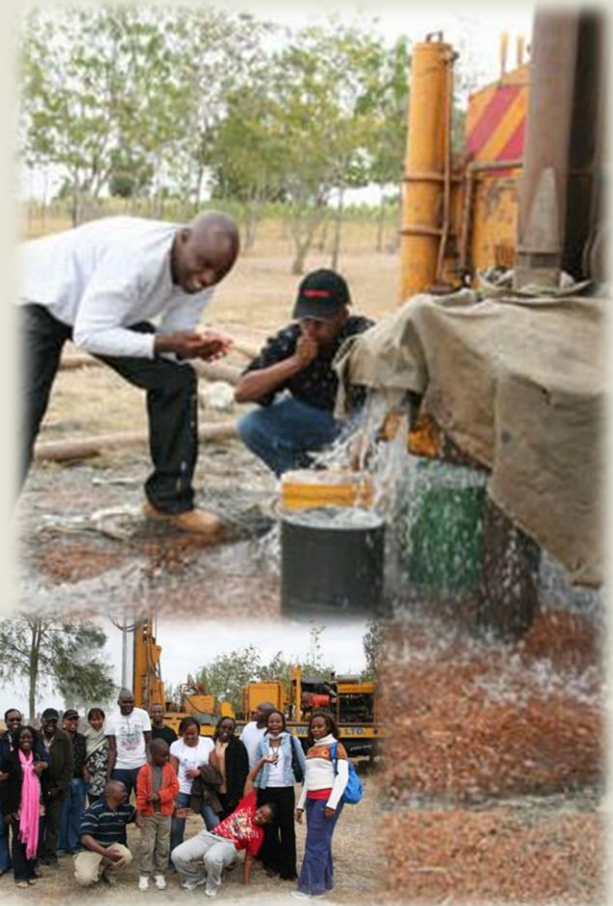
# The Rotary Foundation
