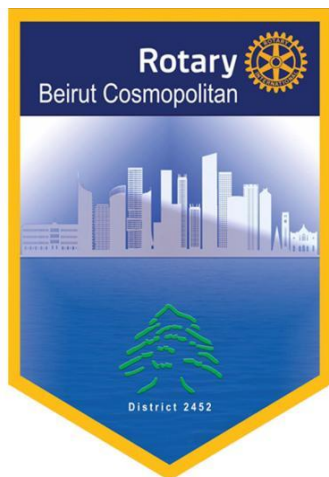

As this Rotary year is drawing to a close, one cannot but reflect back and take stock of the year. Our club with its leadership, enjoyed a productive year, highlighted with service and fellowship, membership growth and successful club relations within the country and beyond. But, the star in our cap as Rotary Club Beirut Cosmopolitan is our long and established history in Global Grants that made significant impact in our communities.

Our club was a pioneer for what started as matching grants to later evolve into Global Grants and over 30 years we boast of having accomplished more than 30 GGs. It could not have been possible without The Rotary Foundation that transforms donations into sustainable projects that improve lives around the world.

This year ended on a very high note when our club completed a Global Grant #2579668, GIFT of LIFE LEBANON to perform heart surgeries for 55 kids less privileged, with congenital heart disease.

Founded in 2015 by humanitarian Lina Shehayeb and like minded Rotarians, Gift of Life Lebanon has become a life line for children with congenital heart disease. Despite Lebanon's complex and challenging socio-economic and political landscape, Gift of Life Lebanon (GOLL) has achieved remarkable milestones:

- 500 pediatric cardiac surgeries.
- 5,200 free full pediatric medical checkups.
- 50,000 children assisted through its emergency relief program.

These achievements are made possible thanks to the unwavering support of partners like Gift of Life International, Rotary, the American University Beirut Medical Center, Hammoud Hospital, Riley Hospital for Children, Chain of Hope London and our generous donors.

Gift of Life Lebanon is celebrating its tenth anniversary this year. RCBC is proud to have partnered with GOL ten years ago, when PP George Beyrouti facilitated the first surgery on a seven year old girl whose heart is beating strongly till today.

Ten years later, PP Mona Jarudi led GG#2579668 together with GOLL founder Lina Shehayeb. This collaboration will enable 55 kids to have a new lease on life, have a heart that enables them to grow up and have normal productive lives.

On behalf of the children, we extend our gratitude to the partner clubs and districts and to the Rotary Foundation for making all this possible. Special thanks go to Rob Rylman, Founder of Gift of Life International, who was tireless in his follow up and fund raising, and to Brenda Small for her valuable help, President Abed Medawar of The Rotary Club of Hillsborough for being our international partner. We extend tons of gratitude to the doctors and medical staff at the hospitals involved, as well as to the staff of Gift of Life. Last but not least, our thanks go to PP Lina Shehayeb whose big heart has contributed to the success of Gift of Life work in Lebanon.

Cheers to the 10th anniversary and to many more years of healing young hearts!

Together with Gift of Life Lebanon, we also supported humanitarian initiatives benefiting LSBF, BASMA, and other organizations serving communities in need.

During one of Lebanon's most difficult periods, Beirut Cosmopolitan proudly joined the Unite for Lebanon initiative. Alongside Rotary Clubs and international partners, we supported displaced families, refugees, vulnerable communities, and villages in South Lebanon, including Marjayoun and Ain Ebel.

Even in times of crisis, we never forgot the children. Through humanitarian gatherings, including a special Iftar initiative, we provided meals, clothing, essential supplies, gifts, and moments of joy to children and families who needed hope the most.

Throughout the year, we also continued preparing future projects for LSBD centered on education, inclusion, empowerment, and the arts. Among those closest to our hearts is the planned exhibition bringing together the artistic works of LSBD students and CCCL children, celebrating resilience, dignity, and hope through art. Fellowship remained the foundation of everything we achieved. Projects bring us together, but friendship keeps us together. I sincerely thank our Board, committee chairs, members, Rotaractors, and Past Presidents for their dedication, generosity, and unwavering support.

Presentation Topic:

“Guernica: the story behind the story - Georges Haddad MD”

June 9 ,2026

Dr. George Haddad is a neurosurgeon, with a passion for literature, the visual arts and music. He is specialized in Skull Base surgery and is a fellow of the Royal College of Surgeons of Canada and a Diplomat of the American Board of neurosurgery. He believes that as long as you keep marveling and learning, life is more fulfilling. He has given numerous talks to celebrate this life of inquisitive knowledge. His public talks included: The brain, Guernica, The pandemics in art, an introduction to Bach and Rachmaninov.

Rotary Club Beirut Cosmopolitan had the pleasure of hosting Dr. Haddad as a guest speaker on Tuesday June 9,2026 to talk about the famous painting Guernica which was truly a very unique and riveting experience. The speaker took us on a 90-minute journey, dissecting every aspect of this masterpiece which was awe inspiring.

The presentation started with a picture of the devastated South of Lebanon now, villages razed to the ground, over a million people displaced, scorched fields, burnt down trees, the enemy making sure that these villages will not be habitable any time soon. Such is the ugliness of war and aggression, hate and injustice. The speaker took Guernica and drew the similarities of the devastations of war, regardless of time and space.

Guernica (1937) is considered the masterpiece of Pablo Picasso and one of the most anti-war paintings ever created. He painted it in response to the bombing of the town of Gernica on April 26,1937 during the Spanish Civil War, that was carried out by German and Italian aircraft, causing widespread destruction and civilian casualties.

Measuring over 7.7 meters, the painting is rendered in black, white and grey enhancing the emotional impact. Picasso used cubist style, instead of realistic expression to convey terror, suffering and chaos. There are anguished figures, including a grieving mother holding her dead child, a wounded horse, a bull and people trapped in scenes of panic and destruction. Our speaker gave at length analysis of every square in the painting, with the total picture expressing the tragedy of war.

Today, Guernica is housed at the Museo Reina Sofia as a timeless reminder of the human cost of conflict and the power of art as a voice for PEACE.

Someone said:

“More than a depiction of a single historical event, Guernica stands as a universal cry against war and a powerful reminder of the suffering endured by innocent civilians”.

One would hope that ugly history does not repeat itself !

On June 16, 2026, we had the pleasure of welcoming Dr. Nader Chehayeb, a distinguished civil engineer, entrepreneur, educator, and dedicated Rotarian, for an engaging and thought-provoking presentation on the evolving world of Artificial Intelligence.

Founder and Past President of the Rotary Club of Aley and currently serving as District AI Chair for Rotary District 2452, Dr. Chehayeb is widely recognized for his forward-thinking approach that bridges technology, innovation, business leadership, education, and community service. He is also the CEO of CPM Project Management, serves on the Advisory Board of Lebanese American University, and remains actively involved in mentoring future leaders.

During the presentation, Dr. Chehayeb introduced attendees to the rapidly advancing landscape of Artificial Intelligence and its growing influence on both our professional and personal lives. A key focus of the discussion was the distinction between AI Agents—intelligent systems capable of reasoning, planning, learning, and supporting decision-making—and Agentic AI and AI Automation, where technology can independently execute tasks, coordinate workflows, and deliver outcomes with minimal human intervention.

The session also explored the transformative potential of tools such as ChatGPT, the future of digital transformation, emerging technological opportunities, and the importance of balancing innovation with ethics, responsibility, and human values. Beyond the technology itself, the evening underscored the importance of remaining curious, adaptable, and prepared for a future in which artificial intelligence will increasingly become a valuable partner in leadership, education, business, communication, and service.

The presentation offered valuable insights into the evolving role of Artificial Intelligence and its growing influence across various sectors. By exploring both the opportunities and responsibilities associated with emerging technologies, Dr. Chehayeb encouraged participants to embrace innovation while remaining guided by ethical principles and human values.

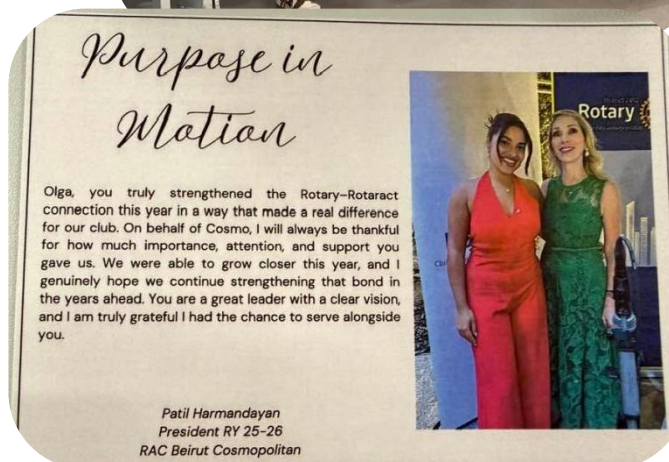
General Club Assembly
