This year Rotary Club Beirut Cosmopolitan has handed over several GGs.

The Elpis HOME clinic was handed over in September 2023.

Our AGBU clinic was handed over in January 2024.

The Bridge of Hope - Dental Clinic led by Rotary Club Monza was handed over in February 2024.

RCBC also handed 100 kgms of medications to Caritas donated by Rotary Club Bangalore Brigades. RCBC contributed 500\$ for the GG of Jain Mission Hospital as an International primary sponsor with our twin club Rotary Club Bangalore Brigades.

On the level of Peacebuilding and Conflict Prevention, Rotary Club Beirut Cosmopolitan has locally sponsored for the year 2024-2025 an AUB scholarship student from South America.

RCBC is currently working on the Deir El Salib Hospital GG, which is still under process.

Last but not least, RCBC has offered a PHF pin to a worthy citizen from the community for his continuous community benevolent services to the club.

On the Membership level, Rotary Club Beirut Cosmopolitan has retained its membership from last year and inducted two promising members during 2023-2024.

Here I would like to highlight our great achievement for this year in being a pioneer club in Inclusion not only in Lebanon but in District 2452.
