Thank you all again for your trust in me and am truly honored to have led our club with you by my side! I am proud of what we have accomplished as a team, united in Service!



Global Grants of Rotary Club Beirut Cosmopolitan

Healing Hands: Restoring Hope at Quarantina Hospital

(Approved and currently in its final stages)

The project, "Healing Hands: Restoring Hope at Quarantina Hospital," seeks to support critical healthcare operations at Quarantina Hospital in Beirut by providing essential medical equipment, expanding capacity for maternal and child health services, and supporting vulnerable populations—especially women, children, and displaced families—affected by Lebanon's ongoing crises.

The initiative aims to reduce neonatal and maternal mortality rates, improve healthcare quality, and ensure sustainable, measurable health outcomes for the community.

Gift of Life Lebanon (GOLL) Global Grant:

(Approved and currently in process)

Gift of Life Lebanon (GOLL), a chapter of Gift of Life International, was founded in 2015 by PP Lina Shehayeb in collaboration with other Rotarians. Since its inception, GOLL has made significant strides in providing free pediatric cardiac checkups and surgeries for underprivileged children with congenital heart disease. Through partnerships with various Rotary Clubs and international organizations, GOLL has successfully performed hundreds of life-saving surgeries, conducted thousands of medical checkups, and organized numerous awareness campaigns and training missions. Currently, Beirut Cosmopolitan Rotary Club is serving as the host club for a new Global Grant in collaboration with other local Rotary Clubs and international partners, aiming to support the treatment of approximately 50 children through pediatric surgeries and catheterizations at two hospitals. They invite partners to join this humanitarian effort to make a meaningful difference in the lives of children with congenital heart conditions.

Elpis H.O.M.E. Equipment Grant:

(In the pipeline for approval)

Supports the provision of essential medical equipment to clinics serving underserved populations in Lebanon. This is not the first time our club has formally assisted Elpis H.O.M.E., highlighting our ongoing commitment to supporting healthcare facilities for the less privileged.

Service Projects

Response for the Rotary Disaster Relief

- 1. Through a private donor, 14 mattresses were donated to a school in Bawaerta.
- 2. A private donation to Dar Onboz to provide books for children in schools.
- 3. RCBC participated in a major donation organized by RC Metn Gate to send food and sanitary products to Rmeish, a village in South Lebanon whose residents refused to leave their homes, risking their lives under continuous bombardment.

On Saturday, February 22, RC Beirut Cosmopolitan organized a visit to the Lebanese National Museum in Beirut.


