President's Report: Joe Dylewski

- Activity Fair 30 Jan Joe and others complimented Doug May on a "job well done" in preparation for the fair. Doug created a slide show that will be shown at the fair to help recruit new members and highlight the club.
- PETS March 3-5, 2016 PE and PN This training session for upcoming Presidents will be held in Mesa, AZ. Participants need to sign up on-line. Club will reimburse basic costs (i.e. room, registration, etc.)
- Next Rotary Social 9 Apr Will be held at Ed Treick's home.

SB Foundation: Bill Pohnert

- The Foundation has received \$500 from Emily's family.
- The treasury (SB Foundation) is in good shape and a report will be distributed to all members.
- Bill currently has six applications wanting donations from the club.
- Certification for grant application needs to be renewed every year during April/May. Currently, Doug May, John Ruland, Steve McNeil and Mark Miller are certified.
- Bill will have to research the need for liability insurance for the Foundation.
- Doug May shared he is lining up scholarship recipients to speak to the club. He has also secured a district grant of \$1,500 for computers.
- It was noted that what the Oracle School really needs is paper. Bill wanted ideas on how best to do this. The "Stuff the Bus" effort generates some paper but also a lot of things the school doesn't need.

Vice-President and Membership Report: Joe McGowan

- Currently we have 40 members. One member had not paid dues and was assumed that he wanted to withdraw. Apparently this is incorrect and he will be re-instated when his dues are current.
- Joe has one potential new member.

ADG/Past President: Jim Lamb

- The next District Conference will be held in Yuma, AZ in the spring of 2017.
- Jim stressed the importance and value of attending the PETS conference.
- Jim shared that the District will move from 4 to 3 in Arizona. Work is in progress and challenges remain.
- Jim shared that we are part of the largest District in Arizona and one of the largest in the country.

 Dan gave a brief update on the progress of generating golfers for the FFK by reaching out to the Presidents of the various golf associations in SaddleBrooke and the Ranch.

Treasurer's Report: Mark Miller

- Mark shared a detailed P&L and Balance Sheet with the board which will also be shared with the membership.
- Mark shared that we are currently on budget for the 1st half of the Rotary calendar but expects a deficit for the last half. However, the deficit should not be as bad as earlier predicted.
- We currently have \$12,757.12 in the bank account and \$5,301.15 in the Money Market fund (Total: \$18,058.27). Both accounts are at Canyon Community Bank.

- Joe will finalize his goals after the PETS conference and present to the Club when completed.
- Joe is looking for new ideas for fundraising and has solicited assistance from Steve McNeil on this effort. Currently the only fundraiser we have is the FFK. Jim Lamb shared other clubs in the District have been very successful with wine tasting events.
- More members need to be active in our activities or we need new members who will contribute to our efforts.
- John Ruland shared that grant monies are available. We should be pro-active to access.
