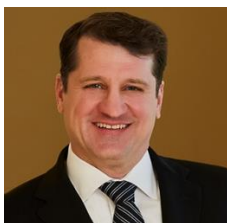

"Follow The Dream" Jim Hansel is an artist with a twist. At the age of 12, Jim was diagnosed with Stargardt's disease, a degenerative eye condition that left him legally blind. Despite his limited vision, he pursued his passion for painting. He has become one of the most collected artists in the United States and Canada, and the subject of documentaries and TV appearances. Jim hopes to serve as an inspiration to the American spirit in overcoming disabilities and pursuing a passion for art. With images of nature, landscapes and Americana, Jim shows versatility and love of his subject matter. Since the release of his first image in 1987, Jim has produced nearly 200 limited edition prints, and has been commissioned to produce several paintings which have been featured by Ducks Unlimited, Pheasants Forever, The Minnesota Deer Hunters Association and TIP (Turn in Poachers). Jim lives in Chaska with his wife Lois who is a key part of Jim's success.
