Here is a description of our duties!

Set-up and Greeter:

We really need your help! If you are assigned greeter, we also need you to help set up. Please enter by the back door near the trash containers by 6:35 am, to help set up and watch to let people in the front door which is closed until 7 am

Ensure that visitors sign in, make name tags for visitors, and announce them when called on.

We have often found that the tables have not been set up correctly by Legion staff, so we really do need you to arrive early. Brad Johnson and Bob Verner are also often present to help, as currently they are bringing our weekly paraphernalia. (Hoping to have a storage locker at the Legion soon!!)

Setup includes setting up the 2 Rotary Banners, setting out member name tags, and setting up the sign in table. Also, can use help putting things away. Please help where you can!

Raffle Sergeants: Please arrive by 6:45 and bring an item for the raffle worth \$20 - \$25. Sell the tickets and preside over the drawing at the end of the meeting. Count the proceeds and give the money to the treasurer. There are envelopes in the tackle box for money collected. - You can also help the greeter check guests in.
