



SISTER CLUB AGREEMENT

This agreement is made and entered into on this 18-th of May, 1978, in Toyonaka, Japan, by and between San Mateo Rotary Club, R.I. District 513 and three rotary clubs, Toyonaka, Toyonaka South and Toyonaka North, R.I. District 266 with the object of establishing Sister Club relationship with each other.

Article I Purpose

It is to aim to carry out various activities in order to contribute to the peace of the world by intensifying international understanding through mutual exchanges between both parties.

Article II Activities

The contents of the activities shall be as the followings.

1. Exchange of publications(bulletin, magazine, membership list etc.), films, slides etc.
2. Exchange Student Program
3. Other subjects after mutual consultation

Article III Duration

This agreement shall come into effect on the date of 18-th of May, 1978, and last for three years. The agreement shall be extended for further three years under mutual consent.

Article IV Anniversary of Conclusion of Sister Club Agreement

Each representative of the parties concerned hereby put the signature into writing on the date of 18-th of May, 1978, and shall become effective on that date, which shall be fixed as the anniversary of conclusion of Sister Club Agreement every year.

Article V Report to Rotary International

Both parties shall immediately report the conclusion of this agreement to Rotary International through the Governor in each place.
