	Late applications accepted to June 20, with late registration fee of \$59.00, pending space available.
WHY:	Dedicated to providing artists with a well-managed, high-quality, well-publicized event. Net proceeds from artists' registration fees support the charitable donations of the Wakefield Rotary Club.
REFUNDS:	Refunds for cancellation by the artist allowed upon request before May 31. No refunds after June 15, for inclement weather or other conditions for which the Rotary Club has no control.
PARKING:	Parking is not provided to artists but is usually available on selected side streets and Ocean Road on a first-come basis. Artists are provided with a vehicle ID display card for identification by Rotary volunteers and traffic officers. All artists are solely responsible for their own parking arrangements as well as any tickets or fines for illegal parking. Warning - Do not park at the Coast Guard House or Trio Restaurants.
