Kristy shared that Harmony Acres is a place for healing for children or adults- including military veterans who are dealing with a variety of disabilities or traumas- physical or psychological to obtain the support they need. The majority of Harmony Acres clients are children right nowthe client mix fluctuates from time to time.
