The purpose of the Red Badge Program is to help you, as a new Rotarian, become familiar with the principles and purposes of Rotary International, and become comfortable socially and in service with our Club.

- SECOND HIGH ETHICAL STANDARDS IN BUSINESS AND PROFESSIONS, THE RECOGNITION OF THE WORTHINESS OF ALL USEFUL OCCUPATIONS, AND THE DIGNIFYING OF EACH ROTARIAN'S OCCUPATION AS AN OPPORTUNITY TO SERVE SOCIETY;*
- THIRD THE APPLICATION OF THE IDEAL OF SERVICE IN EACH ROTARIAN'S PERSONAL, BUSINESS, AND COMMUNITY LIFE;*
- FOURTH THE ADVANCEMENT OF INTERNATIONAL UNDERSTANDING, GOODWILL, AND PEACE THROUGH A WORLD FELLOWSHIP OF BUSINESS AND PROFESSIONAL PERSONS UNITED IN THE IDEAL OF SERVICE.*

COMPLETE AT LEAST ONE ITEM IN EACH OF THE FOUR AVENUES. IF YOU ARE UNABLE TO COMPLETE THE 8 ITEMS WITHIN 3 MONTHS OF JOINING THE CLUB, YOU WILL NEED TO COMPLETE AN ADDITIONAL ITEM FOR EACH ADDITIONAL MONTH THAT YOU HAVEN'T COMPLETED THE PROGRAM.
