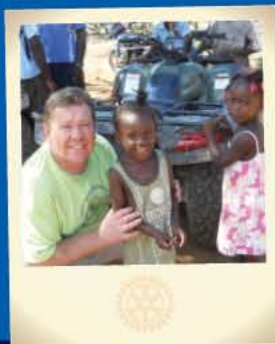
Five Avenues of Service

Skateboard Park (2010) Originally setup at Richards Park but then moved the next year to Bowes Rd
FROM Neighbor to Neighbor (Since 2010) Help others winterize their homes
Established an Interact Club at Lowell High School (Since 2011) Interact is Rotary International's service club for young people ages 12 to 18. Interact clubs are sponsored by individual Rotary clubs, which provide support and guidance, but they are self-governing and self-supporting.
Ethiopia Well Project (2011) Funded a well for the Village of Shanto to provide water for the community
Golf Outing (Since 2012) Support our Youth Services Program
Haiti Clean Water Project Trip (Since 2012) Travel to Haiti to install water filters on the island of La Gonave
Rotary International Youth Exchange (Since 2012) Sponsored an inbound from Taiwan (John 2012-2013), Outbound to Finland (Marissa Sterzick 2013-2014), Outbound to India (Elizabeth Miller 2014-2015)
