

# Rotary

## Club of Broomfield Crossing

The Rotary Club of Broomfield Crossing is proud to offer two \$750 scholarships to graduates of either a Broomfield, Colorado high school or to graduates who reside in Broomfield. The scholarships are available to all students who meet the eligibility requirements, but focus will be given to students who plan to continue their education at a vocational or technical institution.

### A. Eligibility Requirements

- a. An applicant and their parent(s) or legal guardian(s) must reside in Broomfield, or be a graduate of a Broomfield high school
- b. The applicant must be a graduating senior

### B. Vocational Scholarships (Focus)

- a. The applicant must be accepted in a vocational or technical school that offers certification or degree upon graduation
- b. Documented proof from the institution of acceptance will be required
- c. The location of the institution does not need to be in Broomfield
- d. The scholarship must be used for educational expenses and checks will be written to the receiving institution

### C. 4-Year Institutions (Secondary Focus)

- a. Consideration will be given to students who will attend a 4-year institution
- b. Documented proof from the institution of acceptance will be required
- c. The location of the institution does not need to be in Broomfield
- d. The scholarship must be used for educational expenses and checks will be written to the receiving institution

### D. Selection Criteria

- a. Student must be in good standing at their high school
- b. Two letters of recommendation attesting to the applicant's character are required with their application
- c. Applicants must demonstrate Rotary's motto of "Service Above Self" through a history of school and/or community service.

### E. Additional Information

- a. The Rotary Club of Broomfield Crossing requests that the scholarship award winners attend a Rotary meeting during the first year of having received the scholarship to provide an update on their educational pursuits
- b. The scholarship award winners must agree to release of information regarding the scholarship and their qualifications.
