Last Week: Braille Institute

With us last week was Felice Chiapperini, educational programs manager for the Braille Institute. The Braille Institute was founded in Los Angeles in 1919. It started as a Braille library and soon evolved into a Braille bookstore and Braille book publisher. Now, the non-profit operates six centers throughout Southern California which provide fee programs, classes and services for the visually impaired. Felice told us how technology has improved the lives of the visually impaired. The smart phone, he says, has become the Braille of the 21st Century. Smart phones come with built-in technology for the blind and there are currently over 200 apps available to help the visually impaired.
