## Last Week: Direct Current Therapy

Last week we heard from **Sojourner Rick Gross** who told us about his cancer treatment in Germany using low voltage DC current. Damaged cancerous cells have diminished ohms resistance and the direct current seeks them out and destroys them. **Rick** had two areas of melanoma and both were successfully treated with the therapy. According to **Rick**, the treatment can replace chemotherapy and surgery and works on most malignant and semi-malignant tumors as well as damaged cells in arthritic joints.
