as we concluded a successful clothing drive. We also donated business attire to the Robert Half organization's clothing drive and Best Friend's Closet will be the beneficiary.



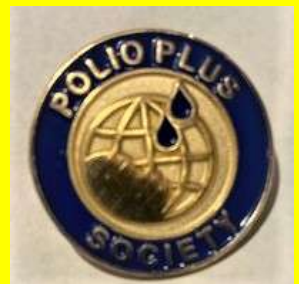
