WHAT ARE PAUL HARRIS FELLOW “POINTS”?

To ANNUAL FUND, PolioPlus, Global Grant, Disaster Response, or World Fund, but not Endowment Fund

\$1.00 = 1 RECOGNITION POINT

Paul Harris Fellow (PHF) Recognition:

\$1,000 in Cumulative Donations

PHF + 1: \$2,000 in Cumulative Donations: Pin w/ 1 Sapphire

PHF + 2: \$3,000 in Cumulative Donations: Pin w/ 2 Sapphires

PHF + 3: \$4,000 in Cumulative Donations: Pin w/ 3 Sapphires

PHF + 4: \$5,000 in Cumulative Donations: Pin w/ 4 Sapphires

PHF + 5: \$6,000 in Cumulative Donations: Pin w/ 5 Sapphires

PHF + 6: \$7,000 in Cumulative Donations: Pin w/ 1 Ruby

PHF + 7: \$8,000 in Cumulative Donations: Pin w/ 2 Rubies

PHF + 8: \$9,000 in Cumulative Donations: Pin w/ 3 Rubies

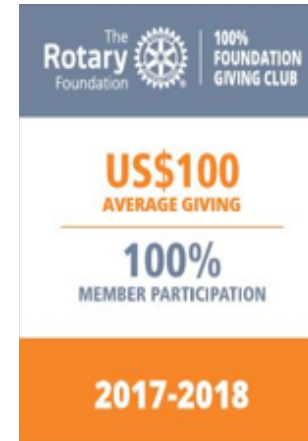

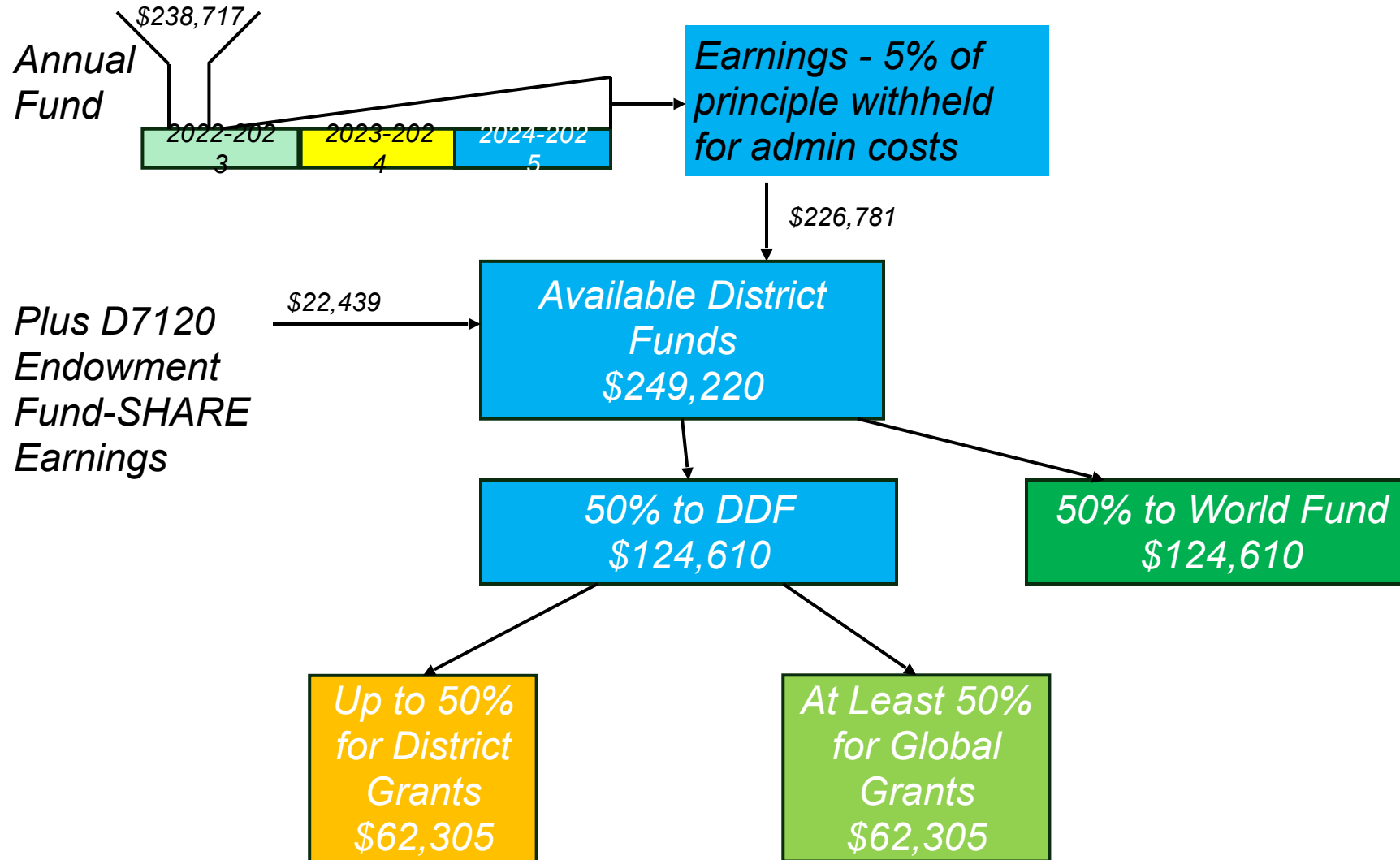

Grant Distribution Explained



Considerations in Allocating DDF

- Though not required, the club should plan on paying part of the expense, ideally at least 50%
- Though not required, the club should have members actively involved in the project.
- Though not required, provide a detailed proposed budget
 - New section on the application form or provide supporting document
- Consider other organizations, groups, or individuals to help in the partial funding and in doing the work.
- The larger the number of people impacted by this project, the higher likelihood of receiving all or most of the District Designated Funds (DDF) requested.
- For future years, work to increase your club's donation to the Annual Fund.

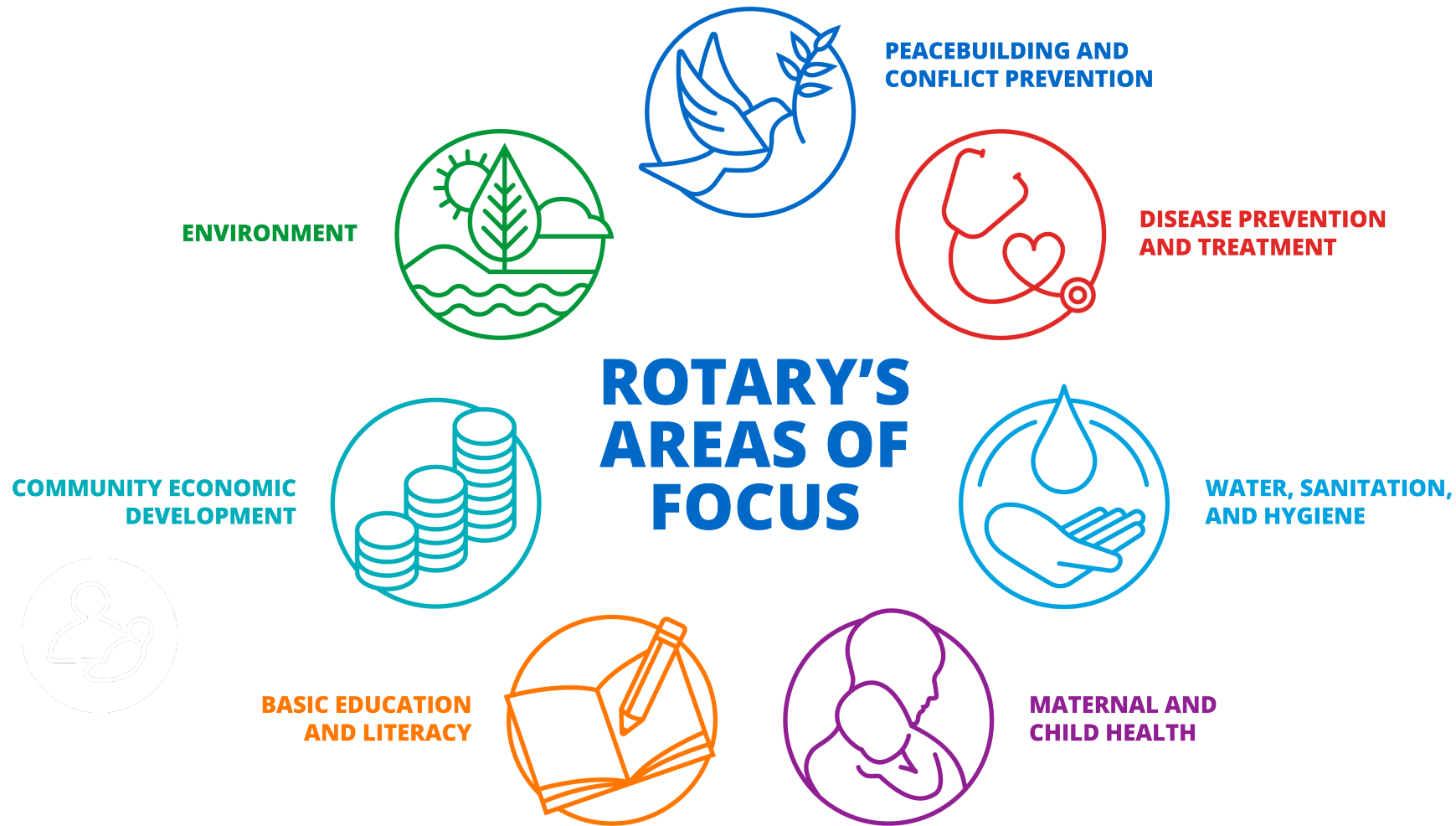
