Each year the Rotary Club of Andover seeks out an educator who best exemplifies the Rotary ideal of "service above self" in his and her teaching of our youth. The criteria that we use to make our selections are as follows:

- 1. The nominee must be a teacher in the Andover public school system.
- 2. Consideration should be given to the teacher's ability to motivate and inspire students and to be a positive role model.
- 3. Much of the nominee's contribution is expected to come from outside normal classroom hours. Examples of outside activities might include involvement in an after-school program, a parent-teacher organization or a town-appointed committee.
- 4. Past recipients and teachers who are directly related to members of the Rotary Club of Andover are not eligible.
- 1. To make the most persuasive case for your nominee state the projects to which he or she contributed and the amount of time and effort put into each one. In other words, state the facts.
- 5. You may nominate more than one person. Feel free to email this form. The deadline for submission is March 15.
